

Junior Scientist Travel Awards: International or Domestic Open to applicants year-round

Junior travel awards are available for undergraduate and graduate students or postdocs to attend brief meetings, workshops, conferences, or research visits. Travel awards can be as short as needed for the purpose of the visit (i.e. 2-4 days), but no more than two months. Travelers are reimbursed at cost for the expenses they submit, no per diem. Applications are accepted at any time and are supported by the U.S. National Science Foundation International Materials Institute Grant.

ICAM sponsors travel between an international ICAM branch and a U.S. branch or vice versa. There are approximately 45 awards available at \$2,500 each.

ICAM also sponsors travel between ICAM branches within the United States. There are approximately 5-10 awards per year available for domestic travel at \$1,500 each.

Please note that presenters and discussion leaders are given priority for these awards.

If an applicant would like to attend a workshop that is already partially or fully funded by ICAM, s/he must apply directly to the organizers of that workshop for travel support as no separate travel awards will be given to ICAM-funded workshops.

Notice: The U.S. Fly America Act dictates that all travelers receiving federal funds fly on a U.S. owned airline (or one with a code-sharing agreement). The price of airfare and/or convenience to the traveler is not an allowable exception. Lack of adherence to this policy will prevent your airfare from being reimbursed by ICAM.
